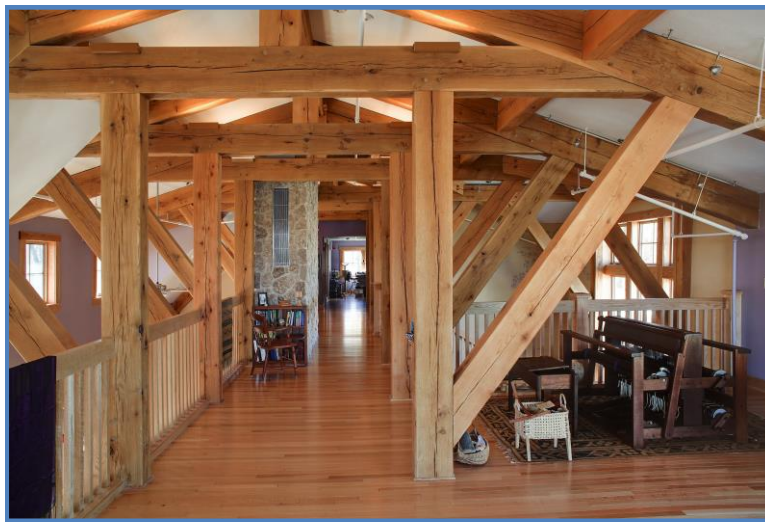

History:

- DJ Construction built three buildings for the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ near Ancilla College in Donaldson, Indiana, to help create the Art Eco Spirituality Center at MoonTree Community Studios.
- The main Gallery Studio includes an exhibition space and open meeting area with dedicated spaces for pottery, weaving, and painting. The Shop Studio provides space for woodworking and metal arts. The two-story MoonTree Lodge houses permanent and visiting staff with space for smaller workshops and private gatherings.
- All three buildings feature vaulted, timber-framed interiors, generous use of daylighting, and provisions for effective natural ventilation throughout. Total square footage equals 11,000. The project attained LEED® Gold Certification from the United States Green Building Council.
