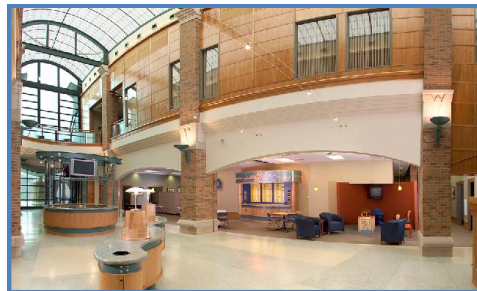

History:

- From the Elkhart County Farm Bureau Credit Union to FBCU to Interra, DJ Construction has enjoyed a relationship with this organization that dates back to the 50's and includes well over 100 projects of varying sizes.
- The credit union was located in Goshen on Lincoln Avenue, east of the current location until 1981 when they acquired the old hatchery building on the northwest corner of Lincoln & 2nd Street. Bob Schrock joined DJ the same year and soon began working with Louis Eby on the design and remodeling of that building into their new "home." DJ did numerous remodeling projects, including the 1985 addition of a drive-thru, as the credit union grew and eventually outgrew that building.
- DJ led the DesignBuild process that culminated with the 2006 completion of the current main facility that stands as a Goshen icon on an L-shaped 2.5 acre site, across the street from the previous building. A 4 ft. dia. tunnel connects the building to the remote drive-thru teller stations. The building's architecture reflects Goshen's industrial base with exposed steel and arched windows, and the overall curved structure alludes to the old silos that once rested on the site. The open atrium, barrel skylight, and rich wood accents on the interior, complement the more historic building elements with a contemporary quality.
- Soon after moving into the building, the credit union assembled a task force (which included Bob Schrock) to re-name itself as Interra Credit Union.
- To date, DJ has either built or upgraded 10 different branch locations. DJ built a new branch in Wakarusa in 1997, and essentially replicated that building in Middlebury, Nappanee, Goshen, and Shipshewana.
